City Tech's Mobile Website offers tablet and smartphone users access to the library's mobile resources.

It features links to the most popular resources used on the traditional desktop site, including hours, the CUNY+ catalog, reference services and contact information. This information comes from our Google Analytics tracking tool and its open source counterpart, Piwik.

Only the mobile versions of electronic databases and eBooks are available through the mobile website.

Users are also able to switch between the mobile site and desktop site. iPad users may choose between the mobile site or the desktop site when they first enter the library's main URL.

The website is based off of a Drupal 7 installation, using the mobileJQ Drupal theme.

Two custom modules, Google Analytics and Libraries, are also used. Google Analytics is used for tracking and Libraries is used to utilize the jQuery Mobile library.

jQuery Mobile is a touch-optimized web framework. It was selected because it is cross-platform, cross-browser compatible, HTML5 optimized, lightweight, and flexible. This makes it more than ideal for tablets and smartphones.
